40 Days of Prayer

The season of Lent (40 days before Easter not including Sundays) begins on February 14. This is a season of preparation, of prayer and fasting, leading us into the Easter season. During this season of prayer and fasting, our congregation is committing to 40 days of prayer. 2 Chronicles 7:14 reads: if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. We will be humbling ourselves and seeking God intentionally together, especially during these 40 days. Set aside a few minutes at 7:14 (a.m. or p.m. is up to you) as we pray together. We will be using a resource to guide us: *Draw the Circle*. We will have this book available for your purchase on Sunday Mornings on February 4 & 11. The book will cost \$10 (Amazon is selling it for \$11). Please get your copy and join us on this journey of prayer and preparation.

Children's soccer teams (ages 4 to 12)
